

Child Safety Standards Organisational Structures



Review:

Welshpool and District Primary School will review the school's child safe practices across each of the Standards and identify priorities.

Address:

Welshpool and District Primary School will address gaps and priorities by developing an Action Plan, including allocating responsibilities to school leaders for completing the actions.

Determine:

Welshpool and District Primary School will determine timeframes for meeting gaps identified. This will include allowing time for new policies or procedures to be considered and approved by School Council.

Update:

Welshpool and District Primary School will update their school statement of philosophy, mission and vision to acknowledge the importance of child safety and protecting children from abuse.

Create:

Welshpool and District Primary School will create a child safety officer/leader position or role in the school to promote the Action Plan and review and report on its delivery.

Conduct:

Welshpool and District Primary School will conduct briefing sessions for school staff members to ensure a high degree of awareness of the Standards and school strategies.

This policy was ratified by School Council June 2018.
To be reviewed annually or following an incident.
